THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST NIPISSING

BY-LAW 2007/48

BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE COMPOSITION OF A PROPERTY STANDARDS COMMITTEE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST NIPISSING OUEST

WHEREAS Section 15.6 (1) of the Ontario Building Code and Section 31, subsection 11 of the Planning Act, provide for the establishment of a Property Standards Committee composed of such persons, not fewer than three, as the council considers advisable to hold office for such terms and on such conditions as the by-law may establish;

AND WHEREAS the Council for the Corporation of the Municipality of West Nipissing deems it advisable to establish a Property Standards Committee;

NOW THEREFORE THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF WEST NIPISSING OUEST HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- That a Property Standards Committee be established for the Municipality of West Nipissing Ouest;
- 2) That the Property Standards Committee be composed of three members at large appointed by the Council of the Municipality of West Nipissing Ouest.
- 3) That the Council for the Corporation of the Municipality of West Nipissing shall forthwith fill any vacancy that occurs in the membership of the Committee.
- 4) That the following be appointed to the Property Standards Committee:
 - a) Raymond Marleau
- b) Robert Pilon
- c) Pierre St. Jean
- That the term of office of any member shall not exceed a three-year term and appointment to hold office should be staggered so that as nearly as possible, one third of the members' term shall expire each year, as follows:
 - i) one of the members to be appointed for a term of one year
 - ii) one of the members to be appointed for a term of two years
 - ii) one of the members to be appointed for a term of three years
- 6) That by-law 2007/47 be hereby repealed.
- 7) That this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of the final passing thereof.

READ A FIRST TIME AND CONSIDERED READ A SECOND AND THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND PASSED AS SUCH THIS 18th DAY OFSEPTEMBER, 2007.
